Related fields of studies such as: Urban or Regional Studies, Public Policy, Public Administration, Environmental Policy or Studies, Geography, Sociology, Political Science, Landscape Architect, or Economics will also be considered
- 3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- 4. Plan to pursue a career in transportation planning, urban planning, or city or regional planning after graduation
